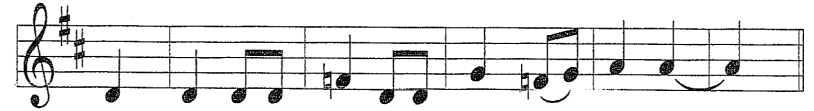

## Renewal of Baptismal Vows

**P** *Sisters and brothers, the Church keeps watch, awaiting the glorious resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. The apostle Paul teaches us that by baptism, we were buried with Christ and lay dead in order that as Christ was raised from the dead in the splendor of the Father, so we should set our feet on the new path of life. Therefore, let us renew the promises made at our baptism. I ask you, do you renounce all the forces of evil, the devil and all his empty promises?*

**C** **I do.**

**P** *Do you believe in God the Father?*

**C** **I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

**P** *Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?*

**C** **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

**P** *Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?*

**C** **I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen**

**P** *Do you intend to continue steadfast in this confession of faith which you made and to suffer all, rather than deny Christ?*

**C** **I do so intend, with the help of God.**

**P** *Do you intend to continually conform your life to the divine Word, to be faithful in the use of Word and Sacrament, and in faith, word and action to remain true to the Triune God?*

**C** **I do so intend, with the help of God.**

**P** *People of God, you have made your profession of faith and renewed the vows of your baptism. By water, you were cleansed and brought to newness of life in the Spirit. May God grant that, as this water of remembrance touches you this day you may feel and know the grace and favor which God has given you through your baptism.*

**C** **Amen**
